 DBS-checked and trained in child safeguarding and emergency response.

- Medical Support: A first-aid-trained staff member is always on duty, and we maintain close contact with local hospitals for any emergencies.
- **24-Hour Contact**: Parents can reach our UK or China support teams at any time during the camp.
- · Insurance Protection: All students are fully covered by comprehensive travel and health insurance for the duration of the programme.
- Special Requirements: If your child has any medical conditions, allergies, or specific needs, please inform us in advance so that we can provide appropriate arrangements and care.
