




Meet Our World-Class Teaching Team

1. SHANGHAI

Shanghai, located at the mouth of the Yangtze River, is a major global metropolis known for its economy, culture, and technology.

1.Economy & Finance

Shanghai is China's economic hub with the Shanghai Stock Exchange (SSE) and the Lujiazui Financial District, often called the "Wall Street of the East."

2.Culture & History

Blending Eastern and Western cultures, Shanghai is home to historical landmarks like The Bund, Yuyuan Garden, and Jing'an Temple.

3. Technology & Innovation

Shanghai leads in innovation, with a focus on artificial intelligence, biomedicine, and new energy industries, especially in Zhangjiang Hi-Tech Park.

4. Transportation & Infrastructure

Shanghai has an extensive transport network, including one of the world's largest subway systems and two international airports.

5.Education & Healthcare

The city boasts prestigious universities and top-tier hospitals, attracting students and offering world-class medical services.

6.Tourist Attractions

Shanghai offers iconic attractions such as The Bund, Yuyuan Garden, Disneyland, and the Oriental Pearl Tower.

Shanghai's global influence is enhanced by events like the China International Import Expo (CIIE).



2. Yancheng, Jiangsu

1.National Rare Bird Reserve: Releasing Red-Crowned Cranes into the Wild

The Yancheng Red-Crowned Crane Wetland Ecotourism Area is one of the largest tidal wetland reserves, home to over 450 plant species and rare wildlife like the red-crowned crane. It is a critical migratory stop for birds and a winter habitat for millions of waterbirds.

2.China's Milu Deer Park: Learning About Milu Deer

Located in the Jiangsu Dafeng Milu National Nature Reserve, this park houses 60% of the world's Milu deer population and holds world records for the largest reserve and gene pool. The reserve is also home to numerous protected species.

3. Wild Deer Swamp: Kayaking to Find Wild Milu Deer

The Huanghai Wild Deer Swamp is part of the Yellow Sea Wetland World Natural Heritage Site, a key migratory point for birds and home to over 300 species of plants.

4.National Yellow Sea Forest Park: Miniature Ecosystem & Outdoor Exploration

The largest coastal plain forest in China, this national park features 652 plant species and is a zero-carbon tourism resort, offering a "green oxygen bar" for visitors.

Milu Deer Reserve

Home to 60% of the world's milu deer, where students can feed and study this endangered species. After participating, they receive a **Certificate of 'Contribution to Scientific Research'**, jointly issued by the **World Natural Heritage Youth Education Base** and the **Dafeng Milu National Nature Reserve**, recognizing their active role in conservation and scientific research.

Red-Crowned Crane Reserve

Observe nearly 1,000 red-crowned cranes in the world's largest wintering site for this rare species.

Yellow Sea Wetland

A UNESCO World Heritage Site and key migratory bird stopover, rich in biodiversity.

Wetland Museum

Features 3,000+ specimens, including a sperm whale skeleton and handson ecological exhibits.



What You Will Learn? Traditional Chinese Arts

Calligraphy Experience in the Art Village


Explore the ancient art of Chinese calligraphy in a picturesque village setting known for traditional painting and ecological harmony. Recognized by UNESCO in 2009, calligraphy reflects Chinese thought, character, and aesthetics, alongside related arts like seal carving and xuan paper.

Huai Opera Experience

Students will learn basic singing, gestures, and stage expressions, try traditional costumes, and rehearse simple scenes—offering a fun and immersive taste of Chinese performing arts.

Plant Rubbing Art Course

By creating plant rubbing artworks, children explore intangible heritage, develop observation and creativity, and build friendships. This eco-friendly, non-toxic method promotes sustainable fashion and raises environmental awareness.

Two local teachers managing daily care—meals, hydration, health, and sleep.


One group leader overseeing all activities and logistics.
